

Spring 2017 English 2890, Expository Writing Prize

The John S. Knight Institute for Writing in the Disciplines offers an award of \$300 (and possible publication in *Discoveries*) each semester for the best student paper written in English 2890, Expository Writing. To be eligible for an award, an essay must have been written in response to a teacher's assignment. The essay should, of course, be fully intelligible to a reader not familiar with the assignment or the course, and it must include all appropriate documentation.

To be eligible for the award:

- a) Submissions must be written by undergraduates enrolled in English 2890.
- b) Entries can be of any length, and on any topic. We recognize that students in these courses are writing on a variety of subjects, and in a variety of forms.
- c) Entries should be word-processed, and should include the author's name and local address, along with the names of the instructor and course. **A complete and accurate list of all sources, in an accepted documentation format, must be included with the submission.** Each essay should be accompanied by a copy of the assignment that elicited it.

Submissions are due in 101 McGraw Hall by Tuesday, May 23. No exceptions can be made.
Undergraduate writers may not submit the same essay for more than one prize.
